- Demonstrate a fundamental understanding of plants selection, uses, production and maintenance by implementing the principles and practices best suited for sustainable Horticulture production.

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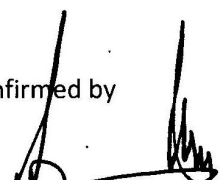
- Application of environmentally sound & modern agricultural practices to provide a positive socio-economic impact on individuals and the community.
